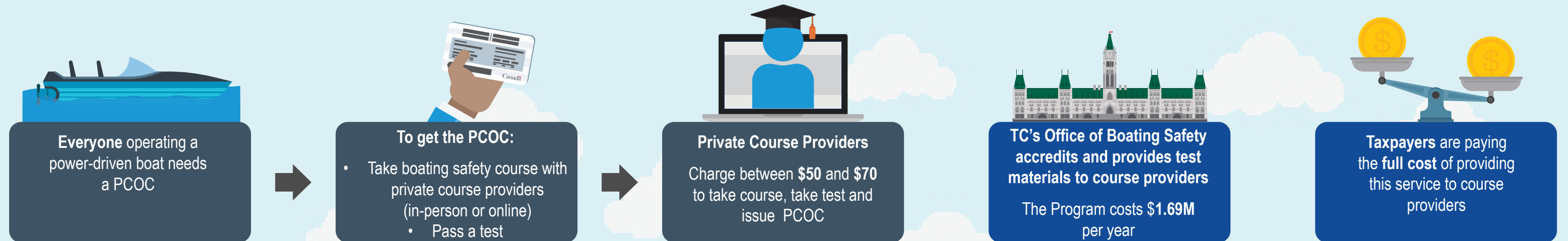


# MODERNIZING THE PLEASURE CRAFT OPERATOR COMPETENCY PROGRAM

Transport Canada's (TC) Pleasure Craft Operator Competency Program (the Program) accredits and provides test materials to third party organizations and businesses, which offer boating safety courses and testing services to the public so they can obtain their Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC).



## PROPOSED FEES

### TC will charge providers:

- a course accreditation application fee of \$5,000 (payable every five years)
- a test materials access fee of \$8.50 for each PCOC issued

### Service Standards:

TC will acknowledge receipt and communicate next steps within **10 business days** of receiving a completed course accreditation application

TC will provide accredited course providers with **24 hour** access to the Databank of Boating Safety Test Questions and Answers in the Pleasure Craft Operator Competency Database System
